Calvin Isaac Rivers, 49, passed away after a valiant battle with esophageal cancer on April 8th, 2016. He was born February 22nd, 1967 in New Zealand to parents Edward and Toatolu Rivers. Calvin was married to his sweetheart Jennifer McCullough Rivers in the LDS Salt Lake Temple on February 1st, 2006 for time and all eternity.

Calvin spent the first eight years of his childhood in New Zealand before moving to Hawaii. He was deeply proud of his Polynesian heritage and its culture. In later years he played for his high school football team, which inspired a lifelong love for the game. He served an honorable LDS mission to the Dominican Republic and returned to begin his career in the field of computer sciences in Salt Lake City, Utah.
