He often spoke of how much he respected the advice of his father Raymond. He in turn always gave great advice to his children.

He served a two year mission preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. He had great admiration for the Apostle Paul and his missionary efforts and he exemplified his life in like manner. He could recite scriptures word for word and was a master at teaching profound truths in his own style. He married in his early 20's and had 3 children who were always the center of his attention.


