of those around him, Michael was able to live an unexpected and wonderful twenty-seven years.

Throughout his life, Michael was a beloved son, brother, uncle, cousin, nephew, and friend.

Michael was cared for daily by his father and primary caregiver, William Ackley, and his mother

and constant nurse, Denise Ackley. Michael was a loving brother to Sydney Cranford, who was

his continual advocate and best friend. Michael was also a proud brother to Maria Robison, his

paternal cousin, who nurtured and protected him through many of his challenges.

In addition to his immediate family, Michael was cared for by his many family members, respite caregivers, and medical staff. He was also cared for and educated by devoted teachers at Dan Peterson School, Horizon School, and ATEC West School, who were key to his development and happiness. In his last years, Michael loved most to attend his Friends4Life day program and take part in his church's Special Needs Activities Program (SNAP). Michael's true enjoyments in life were toys, music, watching movies, dancing, roller coasters, Disneyland, and spending time with those he loved. Michael enjoyed a miraculous life filled with love, joy, and adventure. Michael will continue to live through the love and memories of all those who knew him.

All are welcome to join the family in celebrating Michael and his life at the funeral service on December 20th, 2021, at Eagle Mountain East Stake Center from 11:00a.m. to 2:00p.m..
