Scott Griffith was born on June 22, 1946, in Salt Lake City, Utah. He is the son of Clifford Richard and Lois Amelia Griffith. He is the youngest of four boys, with a little sister at the end of the family.

Scott passed away from a cancerous tumor on November 4, 2020. He valiantly lived with this cancer for 2 ½ months. He was well cared for during his time of suffering by his loving children and wife.

He was raised in Lake Point, Tooele County, Utah. He worked hard on the family farm with his dad and brothers. He loved the Oquirrh Mountains that were so close and spent many hours hunting and hiking in them as he was growing up.
