Our beloved mother, grandmother, sister and aunt, Alice Elaine Chadwick Campbell, passed away peacefully during the early morning of Saturday, July 5, 2014, in Orem.

Mom was born in American Fork to Alfred and Mary Alice Ewell Chadwick on May 25, 1924, the 2nd of 6 children. She spent a happy, carefree childhood playing with her siblings and cousins and vacationing in AF canyon. While still in high school, Mom met a handsome young man from the local CCC camp at a dance, Nephi Johnson Campbell. They were married on June 30, 1941 and celebrated their 71st anniversary before Dad passed away Feb. 17, 2013.

They are parents of six children. On April 17, 2014, they were sealed together in the Mt. Timpanogos Temple.

Mom worked in several places-Pulley's Turkey Farm, Hawthorne Market, Albertson's bakery in Orem, Utah State Social Services in SLC and Barbizon in Provo to help with family expenses. She and her children earned school clothes money picking cherries and apricots in the summer. They were known for their hard work. In her later years, she taught ceramics and assisted in her daughter's beauty salon at Crosslands Senior Care Center in Sandy. Mom loved to do ceramics and create handcrafts that we were the privileged recipients of. She served for over 20 years teaching Primary helping her Co-Pilots get ready for baptism and her Trekker boys prepare for Scouts. She

was a very dedicated teacher. As a grandma, she never tired of being with her grandchildren. She made all of us feel special and loved.

Mom is survived by her six children: Sherry (Karl) Carter, Gary (Terry) Campbell, Pam Reynolds all of Orem; Chad (Verlayne) Campbell of St. George, Jim (Martha) Campbell of Grass Valley, CA and Mel Campbell of Sunnyside, UT. She is also survived by 43 grandchildren, 151 great-grandchildren and 30+ great-great grandchildren; also, her youngest brother, John Chadwick of Ogden. She was preceded in death by her husband, parents, 2 sisters & 2 brothers and 4 beloved grandchildren.
