June 10, 1976 - September 15, 2022

Amber Joanne Ribble was born June 10, 1976, on her dad's 20th birthday, in Ojai, California. She was the second child of Michael Thomas and Linda Sue Hay Ribble. Amber was small, weighing just 3 lbs 7 ½ ounces. She spent a little over a week in the NICU and then came home to her family. At 3 months she had her first DPT shot and contracted what the doctors called par-pertussis. She spent another 2 weeks in the hospital and it was during that time that brain damage occurred resulting in cerebral palsy, intellectual disability, and cortical blindness.

Amber was a joy to everyone she came in contact with. She quickly endeared herself to people, becoming everyone's favorite. She loved the sounds of babies and young children. And she loved all kinds of music. Children's songs were her favorite.

Amber was preceded in death by her father Michael, and her grandparents Thomas Ribble and William and Margaret Hay. She is survived by her mother Linda and grandmother Joann, brothers Jarrod (Jessica), Jesse (Jen), and Eli (Christine), sister Bethany (Tyson) Skelton; and half brothers Jackson (Melissa) Winger, and Morgan Winger.

Funeral services will be Monday, September 26, 2022 at 1 pm at the LDS Chapel 275 Park St. in Layton. Internment will be at the Kaysville Cemetery.

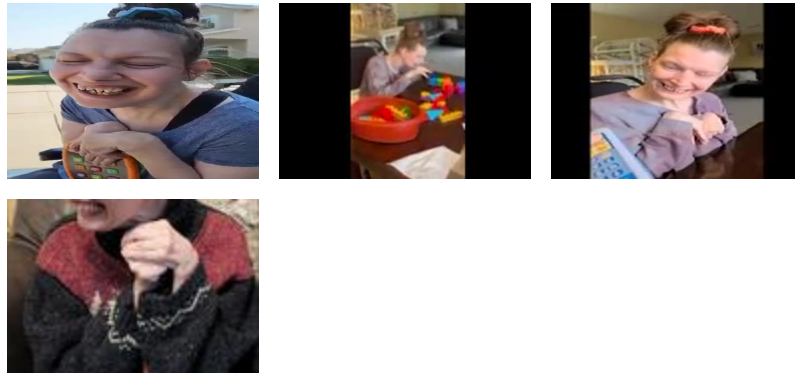
