On December 9, 1932 a baby girl was born to Una B. Nielsen and C. Kenneth Hales in Axtell, Sanpete County, Utah, named Betsy Bernice Hales. Later, they moved with her family to Redmond, Sevier County, Utah. She attended elementary school in Redmond and graduated high school from North Sevier High School in 1949.

She married Lee J. Newman on June 7, 1951. Their marriage was solemnized in the Manti Temple on June 7, 1978. They were blessed with three sons and daughters in law: Kenneth and Jill, Burke and Karen, John and Cozette.

Bernice served in various callings in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints including the Primary, Scouting, and Relief Society. She also provided assistance to various charitable organizations including donating hand-made quilts and other services to Primary Children's Hospital and the Dr. Laura Schlessinger Foundation's MyStuff program, which provided assistance to abused and neglected children.

Bernice passed away on December 21, 2022, shortly after her 90th birthday. Bernice was preceded in death by her parents, brothers Boyd, Kay and Pryce, her husband, and son Kenneth. She is survived by her brother Don, two sons Burke, John and their wives.

She will be interred at Gunnison City Cemetery, Sanpete County, Utah on January 7, 2023.
