Brock Michael Beck, age 41, passed away on June 14, 2024, at St. Marks Hospital in Salt Lake City surrounded by his family. He suffered a severe asthma attack late Tuesday night, enduring nearly 40 minutes without oxygen. Our hearts are shattered as we grieve the loss of our beloved son, brother, husband, father, and friend.

Brock was born on March 9, 1983, in Bountiful, Utah to Tori Stone Beck and Wallace Evan Beck Jr. He married Bruna Targino Beck on July 31, 2015, in Farmington, Utah.

Brock grew up in Bountiful, Utah. From a young age, he showed a remarkable talent for sports, excelling in baseball, basketball, and golf. His love of sports started as soon as he could walk and was a passion his entire life. Not only did Brock love to play sports but loved to watch sports every chance he got. As a kid, he always had a ball in his hand, whether it was a basketball or baseball, his love for sports was undeniable.

Brock attended Woods Cross High School where he played Varsity and started in Basketball and Baseball from his Freshman through Senior Year. He was also on the Golf Team for his Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior year. Brock was so much fun to watch on the field and on the court and often had a very large cheering section of friends, family, and extended family. It was a joy

to see him dominate and excel in every sport he played. Brock was awarded Desert News First Team All-State in 2002 and Leading Scorer in all divisions in the State of Utah his Senior Year, averaging 28.4 points per game. He also held the record for the most assists, three-pointers, and the most career points at Woods Cross High School.

Brock went on to play college basketball at Hartnell College in Salinas, California and was awarded All-Conference both years. He had a deep love for the game and was always a fierce competitor.

In 2008, Brock welcomed his beautiful daughter, Natália and from the minute she was born Brock became an adoring Father. He married the love of his life, Bruna, on July 31, 2015, and their joy grew with the birth of their daughter, Brynlee, in December of 2018. Brock was a devoted husband and Father. He was so proud of both of his daughters and loved them unconditionally. Brock was a family man and worked so hard to provide. He also loved his sweet dog, Koda.

Brock's career journey led him from outside sales for over 15 years to working at several hotels, including Little America. For the past three years Brock has been the Manager and face of Brushworks Gallery and Custom Framing in Salt Lake City, where he discovered a passion for art and a deep fulfillment in assisting others. He was instrumental in building the family business and much of the success was attributed to his dedication and ability to connect with others. He also became an avid collector and art enthusiast.

Brock had a deep passion for music and concerts. During his free time, he enjoyed attending concerts and music festivals every chance he got. He also had a strong love for traveling, nature, the beach, and was particularly captivated by sunsets. Brock was also known for his impeccable fashion sense, signature cologne, and extensive collection of shoes.

Everyone that knows Brock knows that he was competitive, loyal, thoughtful, and caring. He loved his family and friends, and especially his two daughters. Brock had a special bond with his sister Tenli and was always willing to help with her and was often found cuddling with her at family get-togethers. Brock's deep sense of loyalty to his family and friends made him someone you could always count on. If you needed something you knew he would be there to help.

Brock is survived by his wife Bruna Targino Beck, Daughters Natália Goulart Beck (age 15), Brynlee Targino Beck (age 5), his parents Wally and Tori Stone Beck of North Salt Lake, Sister Tia (Eric) Crow of Draper, Brother Brady (Staci) Beck of Bountiful, Sister Tenli Beck of North Salt Lake, 3 nieces and 4 nephews, and Grandmother Verlene Beck. He is also fondly remembered by many friends whom he considered family.
