Perry UT—Carroll Saunders Wayman, 92, died Wednesday, April 3rd 2024 in her sleep. She was born December 22, 1931 in Logan, Utah, the daughter of Willard Gimbert Saunders and Kirstiana Andersen. She married John Allen Wayman, her eternal companion on December 14, 1951 in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Logan Temple.

Carroll considered her occupation that of a homemaker. Her children can attest to her success at that. We knew mother was happy when she was singing. She worked as a cake decorator singing in the bakery, and made several wedding cakes over the years. She assisted her husband in taking wedding pictures and enjoyed that very much.

She served with John in the London England Temple from 1988-1989 and later in the Washington DC Temple from 1990-1991. She spent many years working with young women in the 17th ward. She served for over 20 years in the Brigham City Regional Name Extraction Center reading films in Danish

and extracting vital record information.

She loved to travel, (if available) with a lug of tomatoes and a salt shaker, and visited many of the states thanks to her husband's military service. She was able to visit many countries in Europe while the temple was closed, and went to Jerusalem and Russia.

Carroll is survived by her children; Nancy (Terry) Hoyt, Willard (Gail) Wayman, Jana (David) Christensen, Robert (Cheryl) Wayman, and David (CoraLee) Wayman along with 20 grandchildren and 62 Great-Grandchildren. She is also survived by her brother Willard Saunders.

She was preceded in death by her parents, 12 of her siblings: Aletha, Gilbert, Earl, Mary, LeRoy, Lillie, Dorothy, Ruth, Donald, Donna, Wendell, and Merlin, as well as a beloved grandson Thomas Wayman.

Funeral services will be held on April 10, 2024 at 11:00 am at the Perry 1st Ward church, 1290 W 2950 S, Perry, Utah. Friends may visit from 9 - 10:30 am prior to the funeral. Internment will be in the Logan, Utah Cemetery.
