Chloe Jo Brown, 14, passed from this life on November 10, 2024 in her home in Saratoga Springs, UT after battling depression. On June 22, 2010 in West Jordan, UT, Chloe was born to her adoring parents Matt and Mandy Brown. We treasure the 14 years we have had to be with her and watch her grow.

Chloe is impossible to boil down to simple words. She was larger than life, with a big beautiful smile and wonderful dimples that filled a room. She loved jokes, particularly awkward ones. She loved making people laugh. She loved fiercely. Whether it was all things Disney, or Hamilton, or Bluey, if she loved it - you knew it. She was accomplished in anything that she put her mind to and loved doing so many things. For many years her sport of choice was softball, and she made some lifelong friends from the many teams she was on. Later, it was basketball, and most recently it was boxing. We have such great love for her teammates, coaches, and friends we made along the way.

She loved challenging herself and excelling where she could. She was determined to learn to play the guitar, and was quickly becoming a good guitar player. She loved drawing sketches and we will cherish some of the things we've found along the way. She was simply so good at anything she put her mind and soul into. And that included trying to be a friend. Chloe had the unique ability to see people as they were, and to accept them whole-heartedly for being them. She radiated so much love outward, but the depression prevented her from allowing any of that love to bounce back inward.

As one kind teacher so eloquently related: "She inspired daily with her brilliance, creativity, and wit. More than anything, she was the kind of person that always sought to bring happiness to others...

If I can live to become just half of the person she already was at such a young age, I will know I've done something right."

Chloe, we love and miss you so much. We know you are now free from this incredible monster and wrapped in the loving arms of your Heavenly Father. We look forward with hope to the day when we can hold you in our arms again and ask how your day was.

To her friends and all that knew and loved her: Love each other. Help each other. Care for each other. Reach out. Get help. You are never alone, and despite the night, the morning always comes.

Chloe is survived by her parents, Matt and Mandy Brown; her loving brothers Ethan and Luke; her great-grandma Mona Brown; grandparents, David and Jeanine Brown, Fred and Nancy Luthy, and Tod and Dawn Shirley; many aunts, uncles, and cousins; and neighbors and friends that she cared so much about. She was preceded in death by her uncle Bobby Brown and many great-grandparents.

Services for Chloe include: a viewing on Wednesday, November 13, 2024 from 6:00pm - 8:00pm at the church at 270 Harvest Hills Blvd, Saratoga Springs, UT; on Thursday, November 14, 2024 a viewing from 10:00am to 10:30am and a funeral at 11:00am. 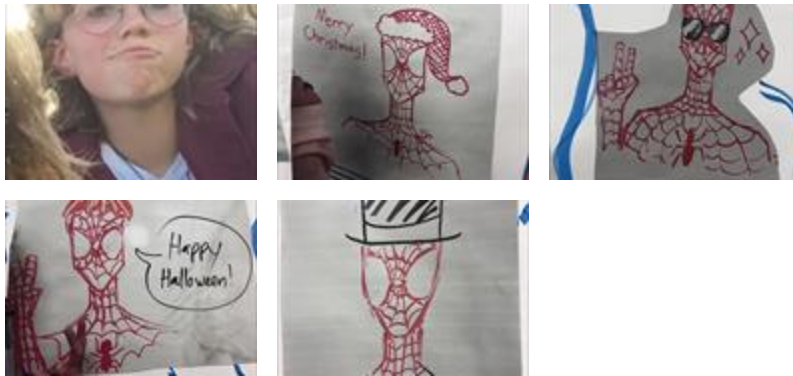

First - seeing as how you did not know Chloe, I must say it's a pretty large leap you are making to think you know her and our situation and it takes a pretty large ego to decide to first think it and second to actually go ahead and post it.

I also doubt you will come back to read this, but if you do... I think one thing you got right is this - the whole situation is awful. All of it. Knowing other kids are struggling? Awful. Going through this? Awful. The struggles Chloe suffered? Awful. Especially awful because for the last couple of years Chloe has been working with a number of trained mental health professionals to work through the challenges she was facing. At no time, or at any point was she ever told, insinuated, or treated like the church was the answer or the good brothers who have led our ward were responsible to help. To be transparent, which is frankly more than you deserve, she hadn't ever even discussed any of her challenges with them that I am aware of. Because of that, I would completely agree with you that they are not qualified (generally) to care for my children. Nor was this situation treated as such.

I hope for your sake you do never have to go through this. And hope for your sake that you learn the decency to not make comments on things you know quite little about.

she's gone, people still choose to say and bully. But know that although these people have no morals, we do, and that's all she needs.
