Daniel Edward Schueller, affectionately known as “Dan the man,” peacefully passed away surrounded by his family, on August 1, 2025. Dan was born on October 3, 1946, to loving parents Gwendelyn Helen Bramelette and John William Schueller in Los Angeles, California. Dan grew up in Duarte, CA building close relationships with his siblings, Ronnie, Josephine, Margarite, Edward, and especially his sister Gwendelyn, whom he affectionately referred to as Sue.

Dan was an avid swimmer and won medals in swimming. He competed in several sports while attending Duarte High School including being on the Cheerleading team.
