David (Dave) Brent Dyson of Tooele, UT born February 27, 1956 passed away at home unexpectedly of heart disease on Saturday September 26, 2020. He was born to Frederick Patrick Dyson and Iris (Lane) Lamoreaux, who immigrated from England to the Western US. Survived by his wife Shawna (Rynearson) Dyson of 35 years, and siblings Keith P (Diane) Dyson, Elizabeth Davis-Caldwell and numerous cousins, nieces, and nephews in which his interactions were joyful.

He talked of his horse Ginger and how they were bonded as one, also of bottle feeding the bummer lambs, along with all types of farm life in his younger years that carried over to their home in Francis, Utah. In his latter years he was the dad of several dogs Princess, Snickers, Patches, Raskel, and Jazz.

Dave had the ability to befriend all that he met and was always willing to help where there was a need.
