68, passed away on 2 July, 2020 at the George E. Wahlen Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center. Dennis was born to Lolan Ray Fletcher and Katherine Fletcher on 20 November, 1951. He graduated from San Geronio High School in San Bernardino, California in 1970.

Dennis was a United States Air Force veteran who served overseas during the Vietnam War. He dedicated his life to serving his fellow man, spending 30 years as a physical therapy assistant for the Loma Linda Veterans Affairs medical system. He was a devoted son, a kind brother, a caring husband, a loving father and grandfather. Dennis was deeply involved in family life while also committed to his religion and his community. He loved camping, sports cars, reading, historical accounts, and classic rock music.
