Dennis Johnson, age 72, passed away on January 19, 2019, in Murray, Utah. He was born January 1, 1947, in Colorado Springs, Colorado to Esther and Perry Johnson. He was married to Vickey Jean Bood for time and all eternity in the Los Angeles, California LDS Temple on June 29, 1968.

Dad grew up in Pocatello, Idaho and graduated from Pocatello High School before enlisting in the United States Navy in 1965. Dennis served faithfully in the US Navy for twenty years, retiring as a Senior Chief in 1985. 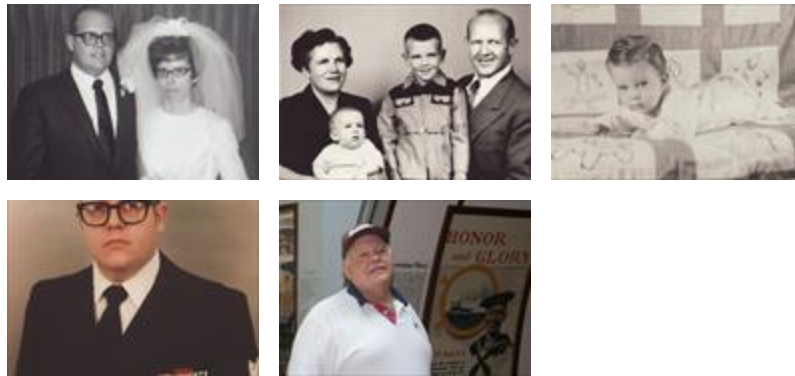
