Devin Brent Criddle, our beloved Son, Brother and Friend was called home to his Heavenly Father on May 29, 2021 in a tragic plane crash in Eden, Utah at the young age of 26. Devin was born to Brent William and Stacy Clark Criddle on March 3, 1995 where he instantly captured our hearts.

Devin is the oldest of five children and always set a great example to his siblings. We will miss his loving disposition, great faith, big smile and loud laugh. His quick wit and sense of humor filled our home with lots of laughter. He found joy in loving and serving others. Devin has always had an eternally happy nature and excitement for life.

Devin graduated from Alta High School in 2013 and was a student at Utah

State University. He pursued so many interests. He has a great love for music and is an accomplished pianist. He loved playing video games with his family and friends. He enjoyed movies, especially if it was Disney, Marvel or Harry Potter, and he would often entertain us by quoting funny lines complete with perfect voice impersonations. He loved our family vacations, but his favorite part was the plane ride. He always wanted the window seat. One of his life-long interests was to fly a plane and had just recently decided to act upon that passion with an introductory flight and hope of becoming a pilot.

Devin is remembered as a man of great faith with a deep love for the Savior. He served honorably in the West Virginia, Charleston Mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints from 2013-2015. He loved his time as a missionary and was able to touch the lives of many people. We are grateful to all who influenced his life throughout that time.

Our family has been so humbled by the tremendous outpouring of love, prayers and acts of service provided to us through friends, family, our incredible neighborhood, and even people we don't know. We feel the loving arms of the Savior wrapped around us as we endure this heartache. We are grateful for our knowledge of eternal families and we know we will be reunited with Devin again. 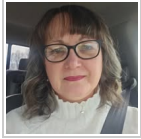

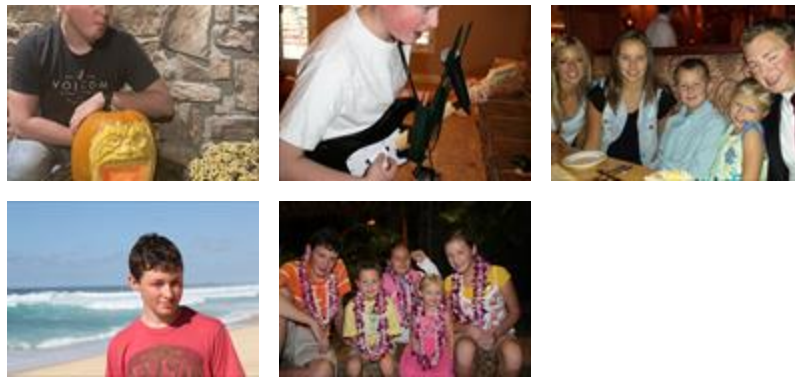


