I was obviously pregnant with my third son and in need of a Doctor. Diane became my closest and dearest friend. She not only helped me find an amazing Doctor who put me to bed instead of bringing my sons early, (she was always the person I turned to when I needed a good Doctor). I took my sons to the same Pediatrician she had used. She was there during my labor and delivery of both Morgan and Nathan. She and Cliff sold me innumerable cars that I could afford.
