Dad would always talk about His Mission and would always say "I served in the best mission in the World". Our Father loved to serve others especially to serve the Lord. He loved the Gospel and its teachings, He loved to read the Scriptures and loved quoting them. Dad enjoyed writing in His journal. Growing up We would always see Dad writing in His journals, He never missed a day. Our Father was a Man of faith and hard work.
