



## Finau George Pilimai

September 4, 1940 - March 20, 2026

Finau George Pilimai passed away peacefully at the age of 85 in American Fork, Utah, on March 20, 2026. Funeral services will be held on April 10, 2026, at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 780 North 700 West, Provo, Utah. A family service will begin at 9:00 a.m., followed by the bishop's service at 11:00 a.m. Interment will take place at Eastlawn Memorial Hills in Provo at 1:00 p.m.
