Floyd Thompson Galloway, 86, passed away peacefully in his sleep on May 15th, 2026. He was born on November 24th, 1939 in Idaho Falls, ID, to Lehi and Annie Galloway. He married Marjorie Annie Davis on July 16th, 1971 in Salt Lake City, Utah and would have been married 55 years.

Floyd was born in Idaho Falls, Idaho and grew up in Rose Park, Utah. He attended West High School in SLC. In 1957, he joined the U.S. Navy as a machinist. He served in Japan, Hawaii, and California. He later trained as an aviation electronics technician. Floyd was stationed all over the states, including Tennessee, Washington, California, and Michigan. He retired from the Navy in 1990 after 32 years of service and moved back to Oak Harbor, WA where he was the first one of his family to graduate from college. In 1995, Floyd and his family moved back to Utah where he resided for the rest of his life.

Floyd is survived by his wife, Marjorie; sons, Kurtis (Deb), Daniel (Melanie); and daughter, Joy, grandchildren, Kyle, Xander, Kiaora, Aslynn, and Teague.

He is preceded in death by his son, Pere, grandson, Bill, his parents, Lehi and Annie Galloway, and his three brothers and four sisters.
