He made carpentry his trade and spent several years mastering his techniques. He was an avid reader. He loved reading scriptures and church material. The simplest pleasures in life brought great joy to Don Beto. He enjoyed getting together with the whole family for parties, barbecuing, dancing, reminiscing and enjoying a good meal. His favorite meals included shrimp, Chinese food, carne asada and sweets. He loved going to The Golden Corral. His favorite pastime was shopping for clothes.

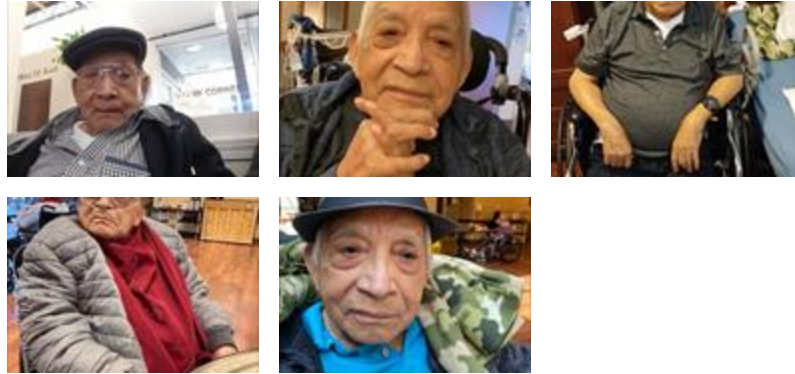
