Heath Ron Kelley, loving son, brother, and uncle, age 42, passed away on January 11, 2023.

Heath was born in Salt Lake City to Ron and Colleen Hansen Kelley on December 11, 1980. He was the fourth of five children and his siblings were numbered among his biggest fans. He graduated from American Fork High School in 1999, where he was passionate about baseball and excelled as a catcher. Home plate drew Heath back to his Alma mater and he relished cheering on the Cavemen.

Building friendships while experiencing life was one of Heath's many gifts. He devoted his life to his parents, nieces and nephews, and built relationships with many others that came to love Heath as family. Heath was never one to define his life by things that didn't work out. Whenever there was a trial or hardship, he would often diffuse heavy conversation by saying, "well, that happened." He had a remarkable way of making us smile, especially when life was hard. We know he would want us to keep his service short and the food grilled. But we want him to know that while his death has left a mark on our hearts, his life is what we will cherish and remember. He was one of a kind. We know he was warmly welcomed on the other side and we are counting on him to "be there" like he always has been.

He is survived by his parents Ron and Colleen Kelley, sisters Heather (Mike) Pinegar, Sheraka Kelley, Collette (Jacob) Haws, brother Isaac (Lea) Kelley, twelve nieces and nephews and his horse, Golden Boy.
