John 'Alan' Francom passed away peacefully at the age of 96 on December 22, 2022.

He was born on October 7, 1926 in Levan, Utah, where he grew up working on the family farm.

He served during World War II in the Army Air Force in Alaska. He was privileged to go on the honor flight to Washington D.C. for World War II Veterans.

He graduated from Utah State University in business management. After graduation he was hired by Montgomery Ward retail company. He worked there for forty years and received many awards for his successful work as a department store manager.

He married Connie Stock on June 6, 1948. They were later sealed in the Logan temple. They were married for 66 years.

After his retirement, he and Connie moved to Utah. He volunteered as a counselor for the Small Business Association advising small business owners for several years and served as the chapter chair for SCORE (Service Corp of Retired Executives.)
