Joyce Wiley Brewington, age 83, passed away on January 26, 2018 at her home in West Jordan, Utah. She was born November 1, 1934 in Nashville, Tennessee to Sam Henry Wiley, Sr. and Virginia Winifred Williams. She married Roy Eddie Te'o, Sr. (aka Tasali Patea, Jr.) in Springfield, Tennessee on November 13, 1954. They divorced in 1966 and she was married to Anthony Brewington in the late 1960's in Nashville, Tennessee for a short period of time.
