Judy Lee Johnson Farmer age 70 passed away on June 12th 2017 in Herriman Utah. She was born September 10th 1946 in Orem, Utah to Boyd and Lorraine Johnson. She married Richard John Farmer in the Manti Temple on March 26th 1966.

Judy graduated Richfield High School, Richfield, UT in 1964 and Stevens-Henager College, Salt Lake City, UT in 1966, She then worked for Booth Fisheries, Salt Lake City, Ut. She received her single engine airplane land Pilot Emergency Landing rating in 1968 and while working for Signetics, Orem, Ut, earned her PHT from Brigham Young University in 1970. She also worked for Coleman Company, Los Angeles, CA. She started and later sold her own coupon advertising business in Chappaqua, NY. Returning to Utah in 1987, Judy worked 17 years at G.E. Capital and American Express, West Valley City Utah. She served many years as a teacher, Den Mother, Cub Master, Young Women's President and Relief Society President in the LDS Church. She loved doing things for her family and friends - paintings, embroidering, scrapbooking, knitting and gift cards – her friends and grandson's all got personally made Christmas and birthday cards each year.

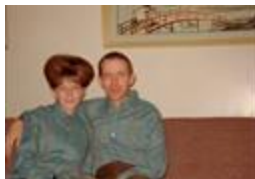
