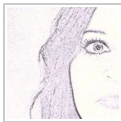

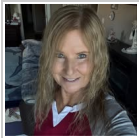
“ I will miss Judy and my heart goes out to all of her family and friends.

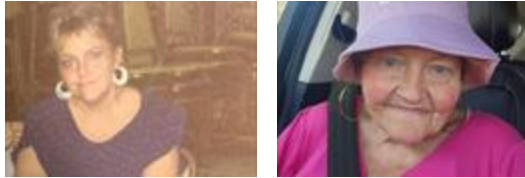
