Kalolaine Kuea Lauaki Angilau returned to the arms of our loving Heavenly Father on March 20, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in the comfort of her own home in West Jordan, Utah. Kuea was surrounded by loved ones as she peacefully took her last breath of life.

Kuea was born in Lapaha Mu'a, Tongatapu on April 19, 1934 to Siupeli Falekakala Lauaki and Amelia Semipilivi Longi.
