KELLY DEE (SHARP) CLOUGH 62 YEARS OLD PASSED AWAY ON MAY 17, 2026, IN HER PARENTS HOME IN EAGLE MOUNTAIN, UTAH. SHE WAS BORN MAY 24, 1963 IN MURRAY, UTAH, TO KENT SHARP AND ANNA MAE LEICHTLE.
