Landon Harding, 9 years old, passed away February 23rd, 2023. He passed peacefully surrounded by his family. He was born August 22nd 2013 in Riverton, Utah to Chance and Emily (Passey) Harding.

Landon finished his 8-month long battle with Cancer. He was diagnosed with a stage 4 inoperable brain tumor in July of 2022. Landon fought hard enduring over 40 Radiation treatments, multiple rounds of chemotherapy, blood transfusions, doctor visits and hospital stays, all while staying so positive and always making others laugh. He had the doctors running passing routes in the hallways. Landon was in the 4th grade and loved math, showing off to the teacher his long division. He loved everything sports, watching every Jazz game and any football game that was on. He played flag football every year and was defending super bowl champs. He loved making YouTube videos

with his friends, playing Fortnite, and had an impressive collection of Pokémon cards. Towards the end he enjoyed waving to as many people as he could from his wheelchair and seeing how many would wave back, as his way of spreading joy to others. Landon had a sweet spirit and was a light to all those around him and everyone that met him loved him. He will be missed by so many but in a short time left his mark on this world that will never be forgotten.

He is survived by both Parents and one Sister (Peyton). Grandparents (Steve and Calleen Passey and Cherrie Harding), and many aunts, uncles, and cousins. He is preceded in death by his Grandpa Larry.

Funeral Services will be held on Thursday, March 2, 2023 at 11:00am at the Liberty Farms Ward, 4105 E Smith Ranch Rd, Eagle Mountain, UT 84005. The Viewing will be from 9:00am to 10:30am, prior to the services. Burial will take place at the Herriman City Cemetery, 12465 Pioneer St, Herriman UT 84096.

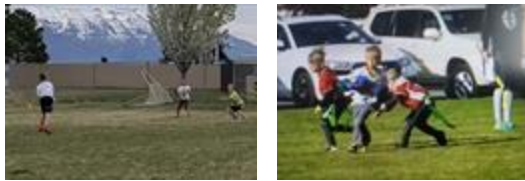
