



## Linda Nuttall Hudson

Linda Nuttall Hudson, 71, passed away peacefully on Monday, December 14, 2015. She was born on July 15, 1944. She was the third of four children of Dorothy Sherwood Clark and Elmer Ray Nuttall. She lost her Father at the tender age of 7 and was raised by her mom in Provo, UT where she attended and graduated from Provo High School and Seminary. After high school she attended a beauty college and later was employed at Signetics in Orem.

She was married to Lee Hudson on September 15, 1972 and the marriage was later solemnized in the Provo Temple. She raised three children and two step-children and she loved being a mother and was a proud grandmother to her 11 grandchildren.

She was an active member of the LDS church, and served in many different callings including serving in the primary, young women's, relief society and most recently as part of the Canyon Breeze and Orchard Park Care Center Branches. She had a strong testimony of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and taught through her example and through her service to others.

She is survived by her 3 children, 2 step-children, 11 grandchildren, and a brother and sister. In addition to her husband she was preceded in death by her brother Clark Nuttall.
