Marian was born June 21, 1923, to John and Ethel (Webb) Hitchens in Auburn, New York. She died September 23, 2014, in Sandy Utah. She was a graduate of Moorpark College in Moorpark, California. She worked at The Big Store and as a librarian in Auburn. During WWII, she worked for what is now known as the United States Army Corps of Engineers. In 1945 she married John Edward Bryant, a US Naval Academy and MIT graduate.

Her early and exciting adult life was spent supporting LCDR "Jack" Bryant's naval career and his later military contracting career. She counted military test pilots, astronauts, aircraft designers and contractors among her friends. Her passions to the very end revolved around raising and supporting her family and being involved with animals, books, charities, current events and politics.
