Mark Winger was born on November 30, 1954 in Salt Lake City to Raymond William and Susie Hunt Winger. He was the third of five children born to them. Mark played sports growing up and was especially fond of baseball. He graduated from Skyline High School in 1973 having played high school baseball and football.

Mark married Linda Sue Hay on March 12, 1990 in the Salt Lake Temple. Linda had five children from a previous marriage and Mark and Linda had two sons together. Mark graduated from the University of Utah with a Bachelor's degree in Psychology in 1996 and another Bachelor's degree in Family and Consumer Studies in 1997. He earned his Master's degree in Social Work from the University of Utah in 1998. He found his place in social work serving people in hospice care.

Mark was a Layton resident for the last 26 years. He was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He enjoyed the outdoors especially if he could be in it with his family. He was a member of the Red Rock 4-wheelers and was a trail leader for the Moab Easter Jeep Safari. He also had Harley-Davidson motorcycles that he loved to ride. He was a dedicated weightlifter going to the gym 3 to 4 times a week all of his adult life, until they were closed due to the pandemic.

He died at home, which was his adamant wish, on September 17, 2022 of COVID-19. He had several chronic health conditions that weakened his body to the point that it could not fight off the COVID infection.

Mark was preceded in death by his parents and sister and his step daughter Amber Ribble. He is survived by three brothers, his wife Linda, his sons Jackson Wininger (Melissa), and Morgan Wininger, step-children Jarrod Ribble (Jessica), Jesse Ribble (Jen), Bethany Skelton (Tyson) and Eli Ribble (Christine).
