



Marvin Lewis Dunyon

September 1, 1941 - July 12, 2022

Marvin Lewis Dunyon died peacefully on Tuesday, July 12th at 1:30 PM near his home in Wasilla, Alaska. He was able to spend his last days with much of his family around. He is survived by his seven children, Andrea (Larry) Lewis, Jeffry (Sharlynn) Dunyon, Bradley (Lucinda) Dunyon, Roger (Pina) Dunyon, Ryan (Genny) Dunyon, Emily (Jay) Minnick, and Craig (Annette) Dunyon; by 35 grandchildren, and 16 great-grandchildren; as well as his brother Howard. Marv served in the Army National Guard at Fort Ord, California and then in Rupert, Idaho. After his enlistment, he remained a strong patriot his entire life and instilled his love for his country and freedoms in his kids and grandkids.

He met Gerry Lynn Bague while she was visiting family in Alaska after high school and moved to Southern California to marry her in April of 1966. They had their first four children there and then in 1976 moved to Idaho where the next three were born. After divorcing in 1989 Marv stayed in Preston, Idaho for the next 28 years until moving back to Alaska where 5 of his 7 children and most of his grandchildren lived. Spending time with his kids and grandkids was the highlight of his life and he cherished every visit no matter how long or short.

Marv also loved spending time outdoors. With or without anyone to accompany him he would often spend a day at a local lake or camp overnight in the nearby mountains around Preston and always had a story to share

about his last campout.

Marvin Dunyon was proceeded in death by his parents (Pharrell and Helen Dunyon), two grandchildren (Cade Dunyon and Hailey Lewis), and two brothers (Ralph Dunyon and Gary Dunyon). He will be missed greatly by his family and friends.

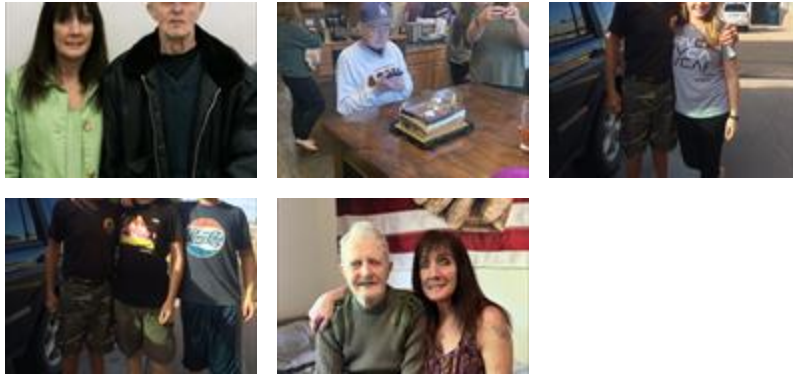
