Max Levern Jensen passed away April 23, 2014. He was born March 7, 1920 in Fairview, Utah to Orabelle Hansen and Levern Jensen.

Max attended school in Fairview, Utah and at BYU Academy in Provo, Utah. Max served an LDS mission for two years in the North Western States and also served his country in Seattle, Washington University.

He trained also at UCLA as a Meteorologist for the Air Force during World War II in the Pacific.

Max married during the war to Murl Acord of Spring City, Utah on January 3rd, 1945 and had a son. Max went to night school where he received his CPA. He went to work for Douglas Aircraft in Santa Monica, California.

Shortly thereafter, Murl passed away.
