November 7, 1945 - July 22, 2024

NaiLasikau Lavaki 78 years old passed away on July 22nd in Orem, Utah, USA. He was born on November 7th 1945 in Neiafu, Vava'u, Tonga to Olga Emil Wofgramm and Sione 'Alamoti Lavaki. He married Neosita Tui'one. They were married in Nuku'alofa, Tonga on January 29th 1970.

NaiLasikau is the oldest of 10 children. He was raised by his grandparents 'Ana Latu Masiu Wolfgramm and Emil Wofgramm. NaiLasikau grew up learning carpentry work from his grandfather Emil. He attended school at the local elementary school. He played rugby while attending Liahona High School. The position he played was flyhalf. After he graduated from Liahona High School he served a mission for two years for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter- Day Saints in Nuku'alofa Tonga Mission. After his mission he married Neosita Tui'one and they lived in Kolofo'ou, Nuku'alofa, Tonga.

NaiLasikau took his family to Hawaii and attended BYU Hawaii from 1980 to 1982. He received his Associates Degree in Building Construction Technology and returned back to Tonga and worked at Liahona High School Physical Facilities Department. He was in charge of their material center. He was also in charge of clearing all their import vehicles and supplies. Because he just loved to build they had him help in the major construction projects. Later he became the Assistant Director for the Physical Facilities Department.

NaiLasikau loved to serve. He served as a Bishop, a counselor to the Bishopric but his favorite calling was teaching in Sunday School. His favorite hobby was watching action movies.
