" I was struggling :) LOL then a few times when I went to get in his car he had tried to unlock the car but it was not unlocking so... I in turn said " Is there a butt woopin going on over there ?"

It was the running joke of the day.

The time spent walking and driving around and sharing the experience of trying to help save someone's life impacted me greatly.

I learned so much about Nate that day especially of how much he loved his family. I learned how to understand the mind of someone on drugs which helped me understand my daughter. I learned that this man would drop everything to help someone he loved and cared for. It showed his true character to me. I liked him !!!!!

Nate and I talked about pretty much EVERYTHING that day. I was comfortable with him and at the end of the day I was proud to call him my friend.

Nate was pretty faithful to call the kids (his niece and nephew) and there were times I would call him to ask him to talk to Dom~he seemed to get thru to him.

The littles (Dom and Koda) were pretty hysterical after hearing the news of Nate. They loved him so much and will miss him greatly.

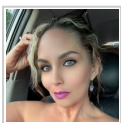
I will miss him also....
