Poli Angilau peacefully returned to the loving arms of our Heavenly Father on November 7, 2023 at 5:10am surrounded by his loved ones with his children and grandchildren video calling from Tonga at his home in Grantsville, Utah. Poli was a humble man of few words but his actions spoke for itself in the way he loved and served others around him. He always made sure others were taken care of before his needs. Poli never judged anyone and always welcomed others with open arms to his home. He will always be remembered as a kind, sweet and loving father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend.

Poli was born of Godly parents to Kaliopasi Fakalolo Angilau and his dear mother, Kalolaine Kuea Lauaki Angilau on January 31, 1953 in the beautiful village of Tatakamotonga. He is the oldest of 11 children: Fa Tuuongo, Lemana, Lauaki, Lupe, Meliame Latu, Tevita, Losaline, Tonga, Sione Singana and Viliami Feilo. He is also surrounded by many nieces and nephews who loved him as their own.

He learned the true definition of hard work and to give/share whatever he had earned through his father's example. At the age of 17, he stayed home from school to help his father work and care for his family. Poli was known for his hard work in gardening as a farmer in Tonga. He always knew what was best to keep a garden of food plentiful and other plants growing beautifully. Many have partaken the fruits of his labors.

Later in life, Poli met the beautiful love of his life and married Mele Fuaimamao of Felemea, Ha'apai. She has since passed away and awaits his arrival on the other side to be reunited once again as an eternal family. Together, Poli and Fuaimamao have 6 children: Atelaite Taupea Angilau, Sulieti Angilau (deceased), Kaliopasi Fakalolo Angilau (Tepi Loloa), Lemana Angilau (Maluofi Vaenuku), Salote Samoa Luka (Viliami Luka) and Tonga Hilamani Stephen Angilau (Pansy Leatu'u). They were later sealed together for time and all eternity in the Jordan River Temple on February 26, 2022 along with their daughter Sulieti.
