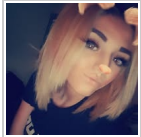

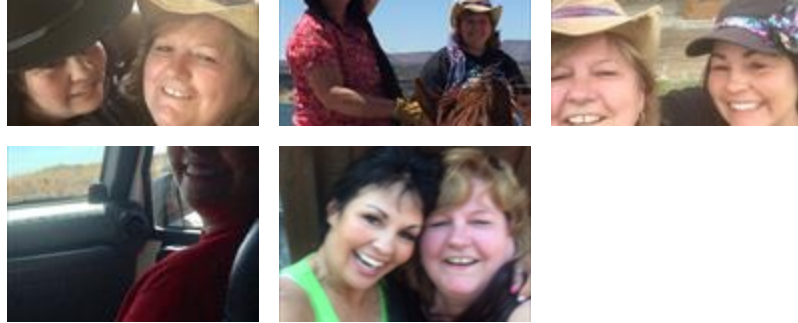
She and I would call and talk at all hours of the day and night to talk of each other's past, present and future; our problems, beliefs, and dreams.

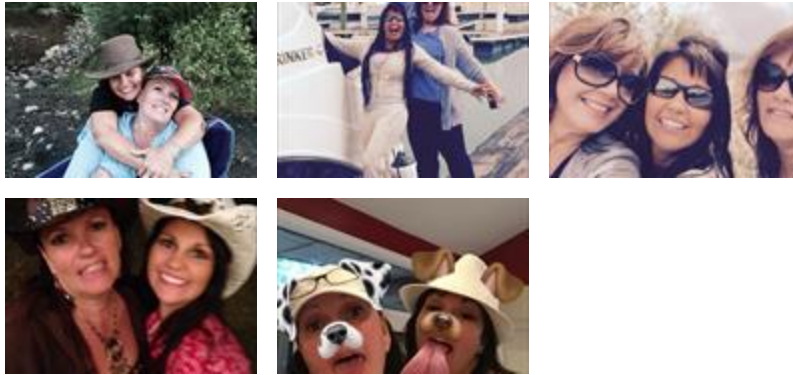

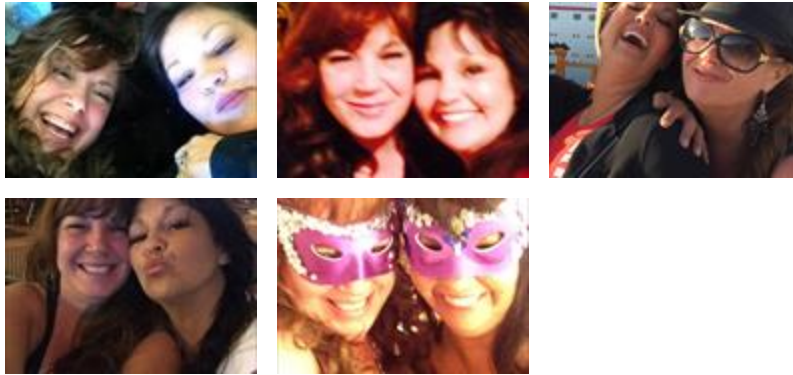
