Robert (Bob) Alvin Carter peacefully passed away on January 2, 2024, at Summit Senior Living in Kearns, Utah due to complications from esophageal cancer. He was born in Salt Lake City, Utah, on 12 November 1939 to Joseph Alvin Carter and Florence Elsie Plewe. Bob married Michaelene Peck on October 17, 1959. They had three children and later divorced, which is when he developed a special loving hug given to each of his children following regular visits. In 1977 Bob was briefly married Judy Worrall. In 1981 Bob met Darlene Riturban and together they welcomed his fourth child. Over the years Bob had some special friendships, including those with Phyllis Miller and Cheryl Anderson (Cowan).

Bob served for over 30 years in the Department of Defense, at Defense Depot Ogden in Utah. He held a wide variety of positions and retired on October 11, 1992 as a Warehouse Supervisor in the Receiving Division.

Bob was happiest when he was actively spending time with his children. He started out taking them camping, taught them to fish, hunt, shoot, drive vehicles, play pool and cards, boat and water ski, even some golf and guitar playing.
