Roger Alan Frank, 79, passed away Thursday July 15, 2021 at Utah Valley Hospital in Provo Utah.

Roger was born July 19, 1941 in Los Angeles California to Joseph Albert Frank and Elsie Laverne Nolan. He was predeceased by both parents, brother Stephen McLeod (infant), and spouse Virginia Mae Morris Day of Yuma Arizona.

Roger worked for different companies in California before joining the Navy during the Vietnam War. He was the radar officer for pilot "Charlie"- flying off the aircraft carrier USS Coral Sea.

Sometime after his discharge from the Navy Roger moved to Utah where he worked for Cubco, a Provo company. He eventually went into auto-detailing (Ming) in Orem and used car sales.

Roger's mother, Elsie, became a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in California and moved to live with Roger in Provo where she died in 2001. Roger was also a convert to the church while living in Provo. He served faithfully in church callings, including as a temple worker in the Provo Temple until his health no longer permitted it.
