He served as a primary teacher and was loved by all of the children.

Ryan was sealed to his sweetheart Alyssa Gleaves for time and eternity in the Bountiful Utah Temple on February 7, 2007. 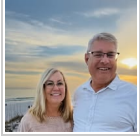
