Sefanaia “Naia” Leakehe passed away on March 10, 2023, at the age of 52 surrounded by his loved ones and friends. If you knew Naia, he was known to some as a ‘fighter’ and to others as a ‘comedian’. It just depends on which side you stood with him, either way you were happy to have known him. Naia had served a two year LDS mission in Nukualofa, Tonga from 1989-1991.
