Spencer Hiatt passed away on Monday, January 26, 2015 in Orem, Utah. He will be remembered for his selfless service to his family, friends and country. He was the oldest of 2 siblings, Haile and Dakota, and later was joined by an older sister, Tacy. He was born in Tucson, Arizona on August 2, 1989 to parents Jeffrey L. Hiatt and Cristina Lynn Kelly.
