Steven Lee Richards, age 60, returned to his heavenly home on February 2, 2015 at 8 am. He died suddenly of hypertension leading to heart failure.

Born February 19, 1954, in Salt Lake City, UT to John LaMar Richards and Lynne Pearce Richards, he graduated from Skyline High School in 1972. On October 24, 1972, he married his sweet heart Cathrine Ann Roberts.

He lived his entire life happily in the Salt Lake Valley, UT. He served loyally as a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints: Elder's Quorum president, Counselor in a Bishopric, Primary Worker, Inner-city Missionary, Stake Missionary, High Priest leadership, many years as a Primary teacher and as a Primary Vice-President to his wife, and most recently lovingly taught his Senior Primary boys.
