Dofi was born in Kahuku, Hawaii to Puipuiifatu Fiso and Ali'itasi Pu'epu'emai Malepeai Fagueli Fiso on May 24th, 1959. Dofi was raised "Parkside" in Laie, HI, something she took great pride in, a LAIE GIRL FOR LIFE! She attended Laie Elementary, graduated from her most beloved Kahuku High School in 1977, and continued her education at BYU-Hawai'i.

Dofi comes from a very musical family so, it's no surprise that from a very young age, she developed a deep love for Singing and could play many musical instruments like the Ukulele, Banjo, Guitar and Bass. For many years,

she used this talent to travel the world and entertain thousands of visitors, while working for the Polynesian Cultural Center.

“Aunty Dofi” was a passionate champion for her people and spent ALL of her adult life in service. She served as an ambassador and activist for the Polynesian community, even doing PSA’s up until the day she entered the hospital. She was also very passionate about Genealogy- Her family was very important to her, she was related to everyone! She held many titles, a Wife, Mother, Sister, Cousin and Friend but her most cherished was NANA.
