Tevita Tuamoheloa Bloomfield, a great husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, uncle and friend, returned home to our Father in Heaven on February 7, 2016 at the age of 66. He was surrounded by his beautiful wife and children as he took his last breath.

Tevita was born on August 15, 1949 in Fatai, Tonga to the late Seluvaia Konai and Vunivalu Bloomfield. Dad later married the love of his life Utulongoa'a V. Tongi on November 6, 1968. They were later sealed together for all time and eternity in the Los Angeles, California temple.

Dad not only was a loving family man, but also a loyal friend. Tevita, a man with many talents, is known to be the best rugby hook in Tongan Rugby history and was part of the '73 Tongan Legends Team. Our dad was like a pineapple, rough and tough on the outside but mushy, soft, and sweet on the inside. Physically tough but had a tender loving heart.
