They lost their mother in August 2018 and that was especially hard on Tom. She had been his support for the past few years as he recovered from Cancer, changed jobs, Moved to Tooele, and other things.

Tom had some issues that really weighed him down of late. Carl and family were trying to give him love and support but could feel him pull away. Friends we have talked to have said that he seemed to be having a hard time. Although we are not certain we feel that his cancer had come back. Whatever his troubles were, they overwhelmed him after Christmas and instead of reaching out, he decided to end his life. He was found by his brother on New Year's Day, at home, with his little dog, Poncho.
