### To'a Brown Obituary

Taufaito'a (To'a) Leafineali'i Tanuvasa Brown was born in Nofolai'i, Upolu - Samoa on July 4, 1942 to Petelo Tanuvasa of Nofolai'i and So'onalote Asi of Moata'a. She has 18 siblings and is survived by 9 of them. She met her husband, Vaifoa Fa'aluatele Brown of Malie, Upolu - Samoa in Auckland, New Zealand and married in the Hamilton, New Zealand temple in 1966. She moved to Laie, Hawaii in 1969 and lived a life full of service and compassion for others through various callings in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and a love for her Samoan heritage and culture.
