



Ulla Margit Mårtensson

April 5, 1925 - April 26, 2020

Ulla Margit Olofsson Mårtensson, 95, passed away on Sunday, April 26, 2020, in Orem, Utah. She was born on Sunday, April 5, 1925, at Lund, Skåne, Sweden, to Johan and Ida Olofsson of Linneröd, Skåne, Sweden. She married Per Åke Mårtensson in Klippan, Skåne, Sweden, June 30, 1945, and they raised one daughter to adulthood.

Ulla grew up on her father's farm, doing heavy farm work, milking cows, and working in the fields. She also learned to cook and clean and knit and sew, She also loved flowers and gardening and working in the earth's soil. Her work was an art and she made beautiful quilts, baby booties, hats, scarves and sweaters.

An important event in her life was learning about the restoration of the gospel of Jesus Christ. She joined The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Kristianstadt, Skåne, Sweden, November 4, 1967. The gospel and her family were very important to her and she served her family and the Lord faithfully in various capacities to the end of her life. She felt the gospel filled her soul with light and gave her life meaning and purpose.

She is survived by her daughter Inger M. Rueckert, (Dean), of Orem, Utah, (with whom she lived after her husband died in January 1989), her six grandchildren and seventeen great grandchildren.
