William D. Maxwell, 87 passed away 8/24/2021 in Cedar Hills, Utah, in his daughter's home.

He was born July 20th 1934 in Altonah, Utah, son of Ellis and Delores Shiner Maxwell. He married Karen Hutchison from Provo, Utah, with whom he had six children. Divorce. He then married prominent Southwestern artist, Penni Anne Cross. Divorced.

Bill graduated from South High School in Salt Lake and attended both the University of Utah and Utah State University. He was an all-star basketball player, leading South High to a state championship and achieving Player of the Year honors. He was also an All-Conference player at the U of U and later was the Most Valuable Player in the LDS All-Church basketball tournament.

Bill was active in the insurance business for over 50 years, and was co-owner of Mountain States Insurance Company of Draper, UT. He also was owner of several minor league basketball franchises, including the CBA's Billings Volcanoes and the Utah Prospectors.

An avid horseman throughout his life, he owned award-winning show horses as well as quarter horse and thoroughbred race horses.

He is survived by his two sons and four daughters.

He was preceded in death by his father Ellis and mother Delores Maxwell as well as sister Shirley Orgill, brother Thomas Maxwell and brother Robert Maxwell.
