She moved to Wuxi in 1983, then Shanghai in 1985. She attended Shanghai International Studies University from 1997-2001. It was here that she earned a Bachelor of Arts in English Literature.

Lois met Warren Krotz, the love of her life, in August 2000 in Shanghai while she was working as his interpreter. Lois and Warren were married on August 15, 2002.

In 2005, Lois completed her MBA in Finance and International Business from the University of Utah David Eccles School of Business in Salt Lake City.

Lois excelled in her career and had a reputation as a superb strategist, compassionate leader, and gifted mentor. After working as a financial analyst for Thorpe Capital Group and Credit Suisse from 2004-2008, she forayed into healthcare as a consultant for Equation Consulting from 2008-2012.

In 2012, she transitioned to KLAS Research where she spent nine years

directing teams of analysts and delivered over 70 healthcare IT market research reports. Within the company, she was universally recognized by her colleagues as a culture leader and invaluable talent. She moderated and participated in global panels, as well as led discussions with executives and thought leaders across the healthcare IT industry. In January 2023, Lois took a new position as a Senior Director at Workday, Inc. She was warmly welcomed by her new team.

Outside of her extensive career, Lois lived a vibrant life filled with diverse interests and an endless bucket list. She enjoyed climbing, hiking, hammock yoga, local gyms, and anything else that allowed her to be active. Lois meditated often and was happy to be in the moment. 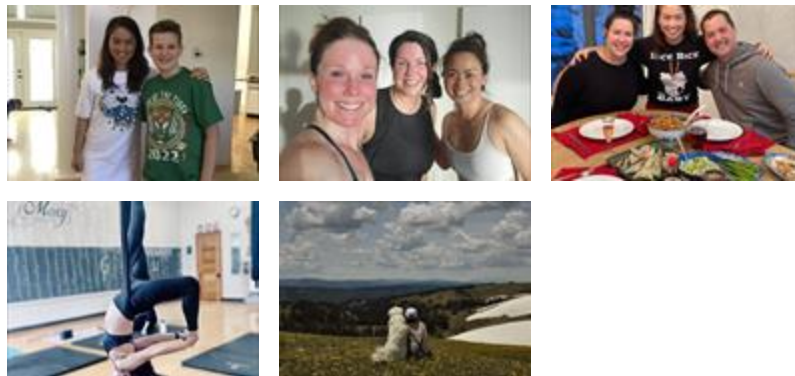

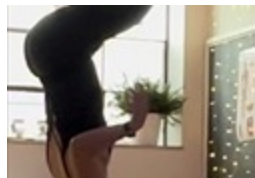
